The fact nowadays is: There is an Ex certificate along with the CCC. Only if we need the Ex certificate to be issued, then a supplementary charge should be paid. But at least the Ex certificate No. should be informed to us already. As it's still requested that the Ex certificate No. should be marked, same as IECEx and ATEX.

Hello Benjamin,

I remember a discussion that in future the CCC certificates will replace the China-Ex certificates. Meanwhile, is there any decision?

Today, we mark our products with CCC mark and the number of Ex-certificate which does not exist.

Does it make sense to ask NEPSI so that they finally start issuing China-Ex certificates?

Otherwise, I'd tend to remove the Ex-cert-number from the product... I far as I know, there is no requirement to mark the CCC number on the product, only the CCC symbol (plus Ex marking, Chinese product name and manufacturer information). Right?

Are there any cases where a China-Ex certificate could still be demanded by customers? Except those products that are not in the scope of CNCA-C23-01:2019, for sure.
